Psychology is a relatively new subject at St Bede's and was introduced following growing demand and interest from our students. We are delighted that the department has grown substantially in that time and, over the last few years, have regularly taught a cohort of around twenty AS students of whom around half continue to A2.

The Department follows the A level AQA exam board syllabus, specification 'A'. There are two staff members in the department and each helps in the teaching of the specification.

The Department welcomes a diversity of students, all of whom flourish. Our A level students combine Psychology with a variety of other subjects and many aspire to study Psychology at university.

The department is a well-resourced, lively centre for discussion, operating from a classroom equipped with modern ICT facilities as well as a small library, utilising a variety of teacher resources.
